LET IT SNOW!

Adollya Prepares for Winter Storm Darryl

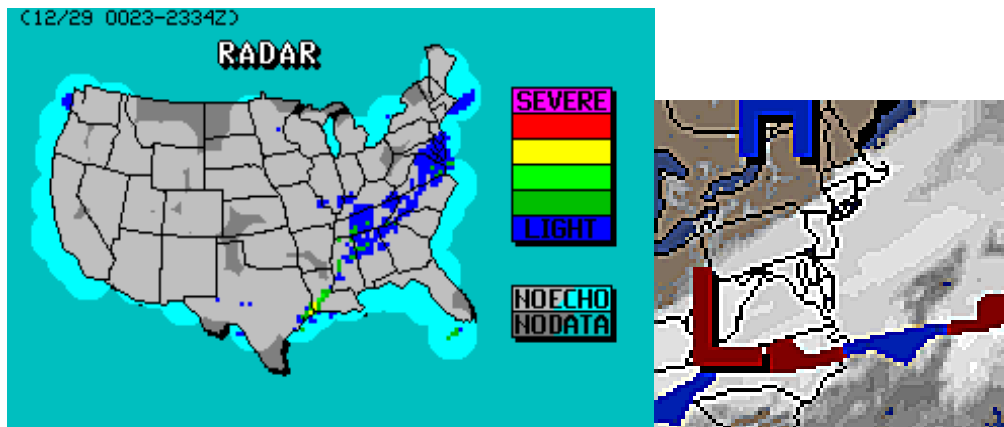
Adollyan Weather Service, Play Porch--Adollyans are preparing for the worst as the country prepares for the expected arrival of snow Wednesday Night from developing Winter Storm Darryl.

"The storm is expected to dump two to five inches across Connecticut," said Sebastian, chaircrab of the Adollyan Weather Service. "Any precipitation will be snow... rain or sleet are out of the question due to the bitterly cold weather in recent days which will continue through tomorrow."

"Snow may not begin until dark in Adollya, but once it starts, it could be quite heavy."

Specific forecasts for Adollya indicate three inches, Sebastian added.

"This storm is not expected to be extremely powerful, but all dollies should prepare for the worst."
